

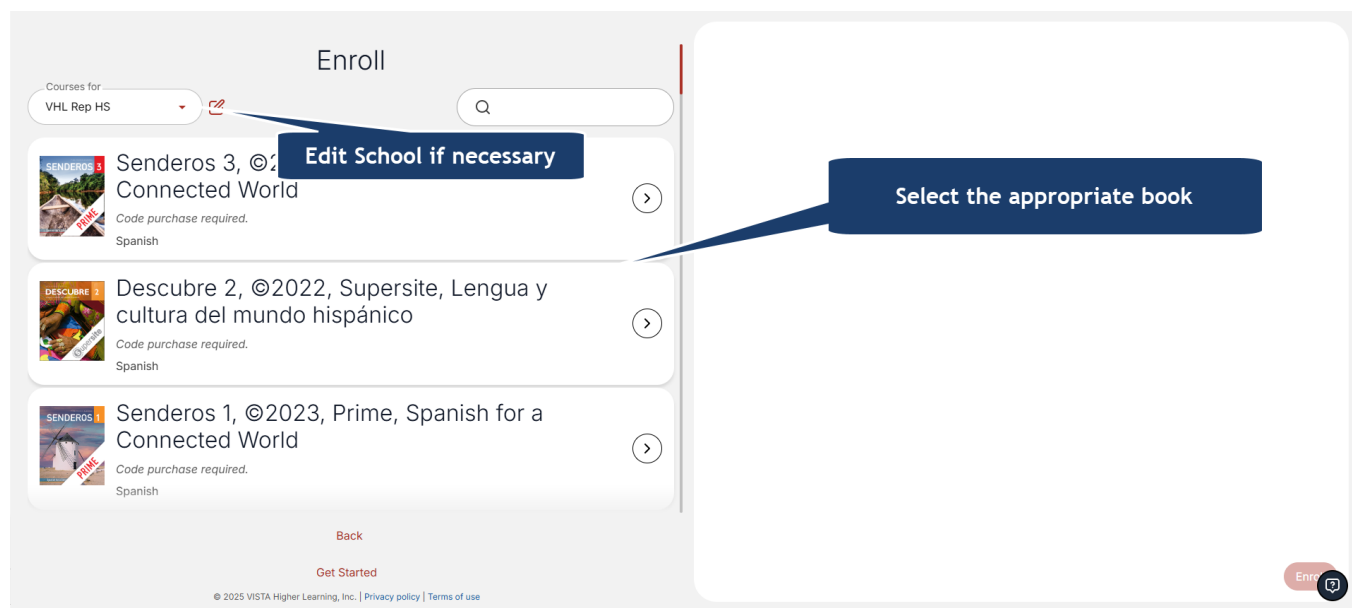


Before students can gain access, the **teacher must first create a course** (level of language) **and section(s)** (class periods/blocks).

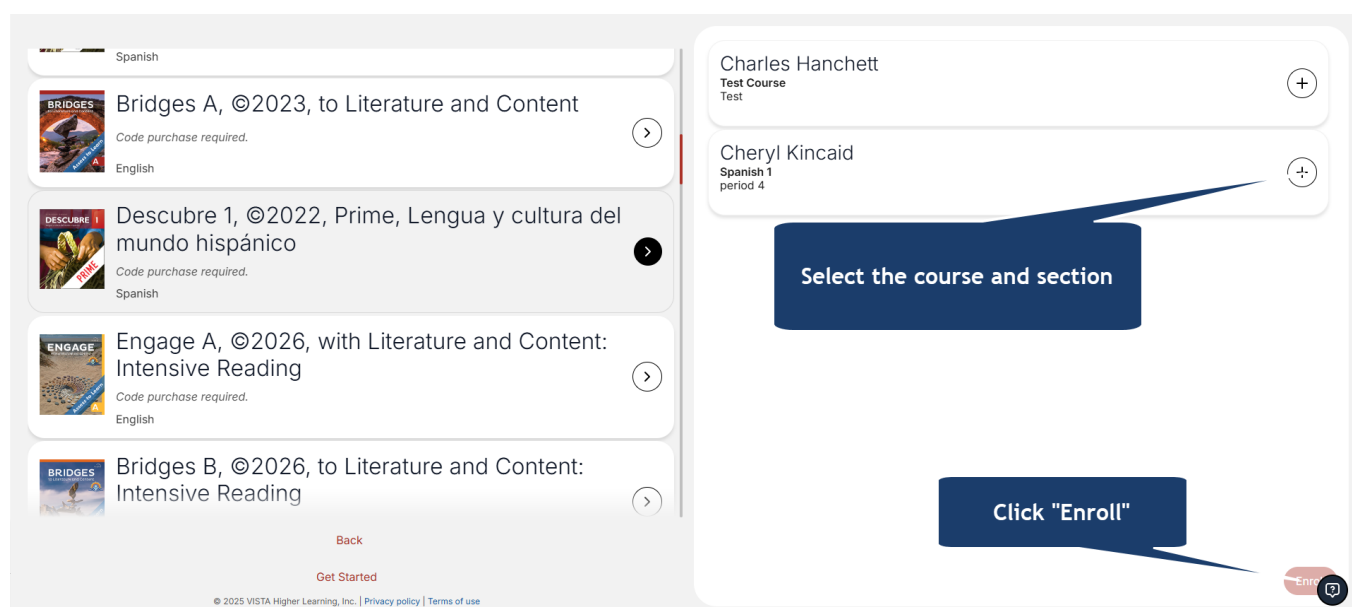
Instruct students to go to vhlcentral.com. Once there, because students have previously created an account, they should click "ENROLL IN A COURSE." If students need to change courses or sections during the academic year, they should click "ENROLL IN A COURSE." Students can even change schools by clicking "ENROLL IN A COURSE."
