A thin Common Cartridge contains full course content (textbook, workbook, and instructor resources). Cartridges can be uploaded into a wide variety of Learning Management System (LMS) platforms, allowing schools to implement that content within their preexisting LMS.

Overview



District does not have to manage third-party application:

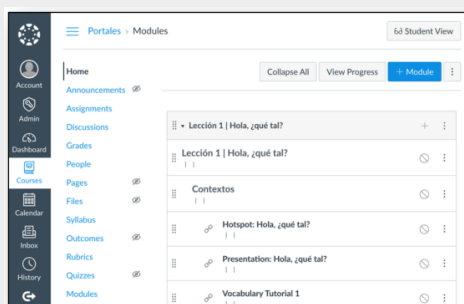
- Course set up and gradebook are managed in the LMS.
- Requires district tech team for implementation and ongoing support.

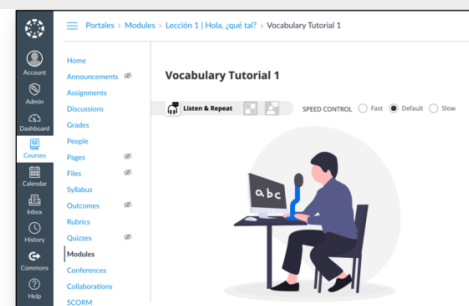


A thin Common Cartridge typically includes the following teaching and learning materials:

- Textbook learning content, including readings and select activities (does not support all activity types)
- Multimedia
- Assessments
- Teacher resources and guides
