GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR ESSER III FUNDS

A very important source of federal aid for your district's language learning programs expires on September 30, 2024. Many districts still have significant amounts of pandemic relief funds, called ESSER III, available to support students and teachers. Spend your funds while you still have time.

ESSER III funds can also be used to fund any activity currently authorized by existing federal education laws such as the Every Student Succeeds Act. These activities include Title III English language acquisition initiatives, Title I support for disadvantaged students, Title II literacy grants, and Title IV grants to support world language instruction.



Vista programs meet ESSER III requirements and are designed specifically to help K-12 multilingual learners close the literacy gap.
